Bylaws Passed

By a vote of 56 to 2, the amendments to the Society's bylaws were passed by the general membership. The vote results were approved by the Trustees at their most recent meeting. A number of procedural changes will go into effect now, including requirements around creation and acceptance of a budget, changes to voting procedures, and duties of officers and trustees.
